Bonus:

The most successful club in the ranking gets a bonus of 250,00 €.

Registration/ Weighing: Friday: 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Saturday: 7:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

All qualifying classes (U14/U16/U18) will be weighed, also including the +kg categories!

Tolerance: female 500g / male 200g

The other age groups will be checked randomly.

Coaches: 1 coach per 4 athletes, max. 10 coaches per club (at least 18 years old). Coaches have to wear track suits and gym shoes.

Areas: In the area of competition only athletes in starting position and their coaches are allowed. Everyone else has to stay in the warm-up area or in the spectator area. The respective categories are gathered in the warm-up area and led to the tatami together. Athletes who no longer have a chance of advancing or competing in the consolation round must leave the competition area immediately.

Set of rules: The basic rules of DKV apply.

Double entries in two age groups are not allowed!
(Exception: U21 & Seniors)

In case of a small amount of attendees the organizer has the right to merge groups.

Kata: Flag-system in K. O.-system (with repechage)

Kata rules for the U10 age group

A-B-A-B. The athletes will perform the katas in parallel. For kata teams, they will perform one after the other.

Kata rules for the U12 age group

Mode A-B-C-A or B; The last kata may not be repeated immediately. The athletes and teams will perform the katas one after the other.

Kata rules for the U14 age group

Mode A-B-C-D-A or B/C; The last kata may not be repeated immediately. The athletes and teams will perform the katas one after the other

Kata rules for the U16, U18, U21 age groups, Seniors & Masters:

Mode A-B-C-D-E-A

The athletes and teams will perform the katas one after the other.

Bunkai is not required for kata teams.

<u>Kumite:</u>	K.O.-system (with repechage)
Fight time:	
U10	1:15 minutes
U12, U14	1:30 minutes
U16, U18, Masters	2:00 minutes
U21, Seniors	3:00 minutes

The DKV qualification classes (U14/U16/U18) will be officiated with 5 referees.

Protectors:

U10/U12/U14	Fist protectors, mouth guards, foot/shin guards, helmets and body protection (in accordance with WKF specifications – but do not have to be WKF-approved). From U12 onwards, chest and groin protection are also compulsory.
From U16	Fist protectors, mouth guards, foot/shin guards, chest protectors/groin guards, Body protector (obligation)

Protest fee: EUR 150.00
